Arkansas Electronic Transcript System (Triand)



- Triand is a user-friendly way to transfer student transcripts between districts, schools and colleges.
- Public schools, charter schools, and universities in Arkansas are required to use the electronic transcript system pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §6-80-107.
- When a student transfers from an Arkansas public school or charter schools to another Arkansas public school or charter school, the first step is for the “new” school to send a Triand Transcript Request to the previous school. This serves as the official request for records and indicates to the previous school to withdraw the student from eSchool within 24 hours because the student is actively enrolled at the “new” school.

Overview

Enter letters or numbers to start the search. Searching is automatic as you make changes.

The Basic Keyword Search searches for any field that is displayed in the search results.

The Advanced Search searches for any field that is downloaded in the CSV file. Permission from your district is required to use the Advanced Search.

Basic Keyword Search

The basic keyword searches for any field that is displayed in the search results:

- The name of the student, school, or district.
- Student identifiers Local-ID, State-ID or National-ID.
- Student date of birth or last four of student's SSN.
- Any SSN that begins with a '9' (which indicates that the number is NOT an SSN, but a random number assigned by the district).
- Student enrollment date or graduation date.

There are a couple of handy hints:

- Enter part of the first and last name. For instance 'Bil Ad' would find 'William Adams'.
- Notice first names match against common nicknames:
 - Billy finds william,willy,bell,bela,bill,will,billy and willie
 - Betty finds elizabeth,libby,lisa,lib,lizzie,eliza,betsy,liza,betty,bessie,bess,beth and liz
 - Richy finds richard,dick,dickon,dickie,dicky,rick,rich,ricky
- Start typing in an identifier. The search results will start showing the students who's State-ID, Local-ID, National-ID, last four of SSN or an SSN that begins with a '9' are close to what has been entered.
- Start typing a date in the format YYYYMMDD. The search results will start with students who's enrollment date, or graduation date that are close to what has been entered. Notice that the beginning of a date usually also finds identifiers that have the same numbers.
- Enter an exact SSN (with the dashes like 111-22-3333) to find a record matching that SSN. Click
