Rule	Column	Definition
	Total Students	Number of students in 12th grade.
	Qualified	Students who qualify based upon credits already earned.
	Qualified With Schedule	Students who qualify assuming that they also will earn full credit for all currently scheduled classes.
1	English 9th	Earn 1 credit for one of 410000, 510010, 510020, 510030, 510040, 519910, 517100
2	English 10th	Earn 1 credit for one of 411000, 511010, 511020, 511030, 519920, 517100
3	English 11th	Earn 1 credit for one of 412000, 512010, 512020, 512030, 519930, 517030, 517040, 517100, 517200
4	English 12th	Earn 1 credit for one of 413000, 413010, 513010, 513020, 513030, 519900, 519940, 517030, 517040, 517100, 517200
5	Oral Communications	Earn 0.5 credit for one of 414000, 414010, 414020, 414050, 414100, 514010, 514020, 514000

17	Social Studies (3 total)	Earn 3 total Social Studies credits. 2.5 credits from meeting rules #14, 15, 16. The remaining 0.5 credit can be earned from a Social Studies elective (473000, 474200, 570040, 474100, 474400, 474500, 474600, 571030, 572010, 573010, 579000, 579010, 579020, 579030, 579040, 579080, 579120, 579150, 579160, 579170, 579180, 579190, 579900) or from Economics (if coded to meet Social Studies - 474300, 574000, 579130, 579140)
18	Economics	Earn 0.5 credit for one of 474300, 492280, 574000, 579130, 579140 - these credits will be applied to the total required 3 credits for Social Studies or to Rule 21 (Career Focus) if code 492280 is used
19	Health and Safety	Earn 0.5 credit for one of 480000, 480950, 580010, 580900
20	Physical Education	Earn 0.5 credit for one of 485000, 485010, 485950, 585010, 585020, 585900
21	Career Focus	Six units from course codes starting with a 4 or 5 (Note: Credit from rule #17 can/will be counted here as well)
22	Total Smart Core Credits	The number of credits earned from the courses listed above (Note: Some course codes may count towards more than one rule.)
